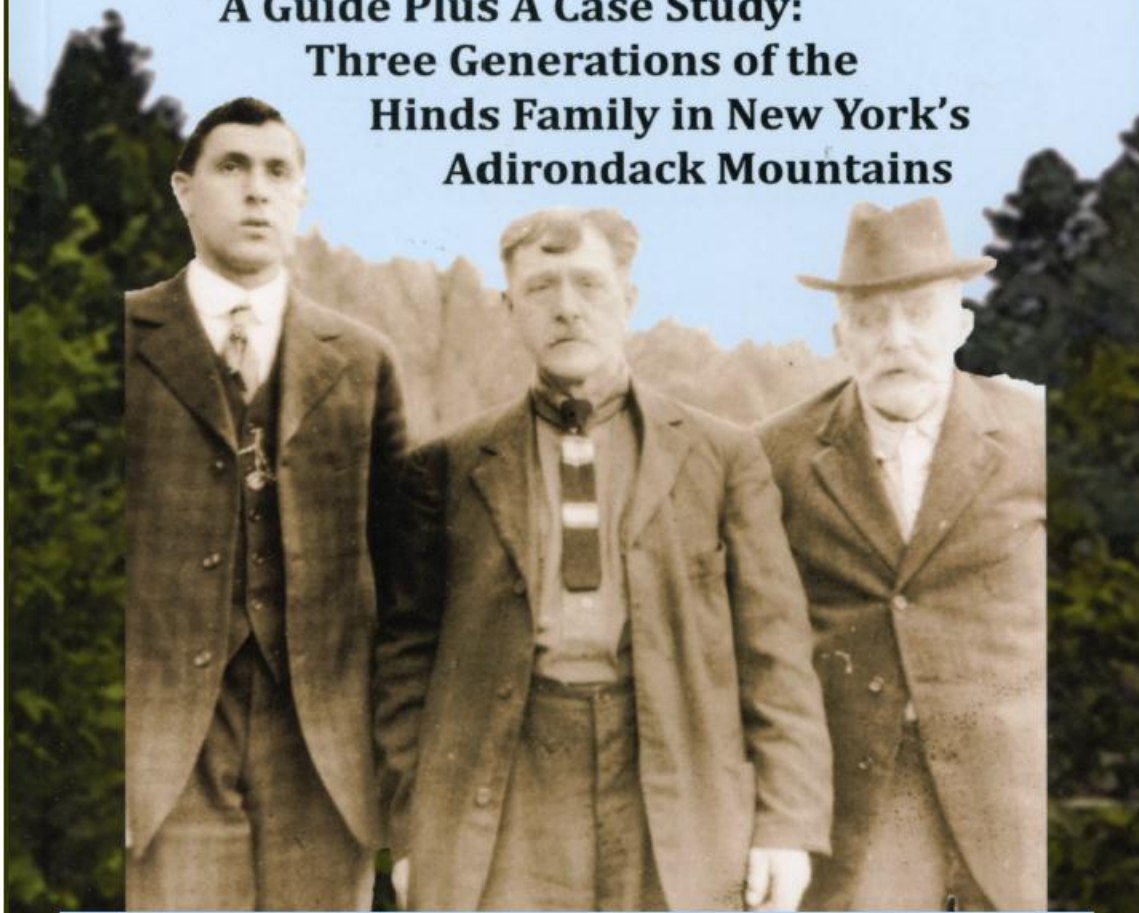


Crafting a Personal Family History
